BJP has no presence in Telangana, Congress will retain power again: TPCC chief

Hyderabad, June 20 : Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC) president Mahesh Kumar Goud asserted that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has no presence in Telangana and the Congress party is poised to secure a second consecutive term in government. This statement was made during a Satyagraha Diksha held at Gandhi Bhavan on Saturday, organised in conjunction with the Rajiv Gandhi Panchayat Raj Sangathan. The protest was a response to the rejection of the Rajya Sabha nomination for Meenakshi Natarajan, who serves as the Telangana Congress in-charge. The TPCC chief elaborated that the BJP's actions in Meenakshi Natarajan's case constituted a violation of all established norms and an affront to the Indian Constitution. He controversially suggested that the Election Returning Officer, who he claims acted without any case against Natarajan and thereby facilitated the victory of a BJP candidate from

Madhya Pradesh, deserved severe punishment. Furthermore, he drew a parallel with the Jharkhand Rajya Sabha elections, where he alleged an independent candidate backed by industrialist Mukesh Ambani was given a second chance despite lacking proper documentation. In contrast, he argued, the BJP had unjustly seized the Congress's seat in Natarajan's case, notwithstanding the absence of any charges against her.
